TURN OFF YOUR UNIT.

By turning off your AC unit, either at the thermostat or directly from the breaker panel, you are preventing further water from being created, and essentially stopping the leak until a service provider can get to your home.

CHANGE YOUR AIR FILTERS REGULARLY

Regularly changing your AC filters helps keep the air flowing freely through your unit, improving the indoor air quality in the house. This is extremely important because proper airflow is essential for your HVAC unit to operate properly.



CLEAN THE CONDENSATE DRAIN LINE

Water leaks are often the result of your drain line becoming blocked. We recommend having your drain line cleaned 1-2 times per year to prevent build up. It's essential not to use harsh chemicals since this could cause damage to other parts of your AC unit. Contact AC Professionals.
